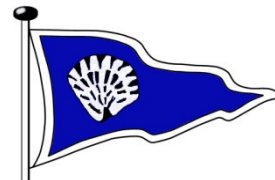

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the RYA, the Sailing Instructions, the notice of race and the Dart 18 Class Rules.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising will be restricted to category C.

3 ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 One member of each sailing team must be a current member of the UKIDA and /or their own National Dart18 Association.

4 ENTRY

- 4.1 Entry on or before Saturday 18 September 2010. The RSC registration / entry office is open between 1000hrs and 1200hrs 18th September. Entry fee for six -race series £48.00 **This includes 2 x supper tickets for the Saturday evening, car, boat and trailer parking at Windsport.**

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Registration: Saturday 18th September from 1000hrs to 1200hrs
- 5.2 There will be a briefing for Competitors on Saturday 18 September at 1130hrs Other meetings may be scheduled as required.
- 5.3 Schedule of racing:

- 5.4 Scheduled times will be subject to amendment if conditions dictate.

6 SCRUTINEERING

- 6.1 Scrutineering and inspection will be carried out at the discretion of, and organised by the UK National Dart 18 Class Association.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and prior to the event on the Restronguet Sailing Club website (www.mysailingclub.org).

8 VENUE & PARKING

- 8.1 Directions: See the Restronguet Sailing Club website (www.mysailingclub.org - Maps and Locations section) for directions to the club, it's location and the location of Race area.
- 8.2 BOAT PARKING: Windsport boat park and rigging area included in entry fee.
- 8.3 CAR PARKING: Windsport car parking (one car per entry) included in entry fee.

Windsport is directly behind RSC and has direct access into the dinghy park. So easiest to park and unload there!

For boat or car parking before 18th September please contact *Windsport* 01326 376192 to arrange access.

9 THE COURSES

9.1 The courses will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

10 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

10.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board on the clubhouse front wall.

11 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

11.1 Any change to the Sailing Instructions will be posted at least one hour before the advertised starting time of the race concerned. Any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 2000 on the day before it will take effect.

12 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

12.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flagpole adjacent to the slipway.

12.2 When flag AP is hoisted ashore, boats are requested not to leave the shore until this signal is removed. This amends race signal AP.

14 SCORING

14.1 The Low Point Scoring System in A2 will apply.

14.2 The number of races to count will be one less than the number of races sailed. If only two races are sailed both will count and should only one race be sailed this will constitute a series for the event.

15 SAFETY

15.1 Flag Y will not be flown. Adequate personal buoyancy must be worn by all competitors whilst afloat. This amends Rule 40.

15.2 A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee as soon as possible

15.3 The tallying system will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

16 REPLACEMENT OF CREW OR EQUIPMENT

16.1 Substitution of competitors will not be allowed without prior approval of the race committee.

17 EQUIPMENT AND SCRUTINEERING CHECKS

17.1 A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the class rules and sailing instructions.

18 SUPPORT BOATS

18.1 Team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal for the first class to start until all boats have finished or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.

19 RADIO COMMUNICATION

19.1 A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

20 PRIZES

20.1 Prizes will be awarded to 1st , 2nd , 3rd boats

20.2 The presentations will take place as soon as possible after the finish of the event.

21 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

21.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

22 INSURANCE

22.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2 million.

23 SOCIAL EVENTS
