£40 per boat double handed

£25 per boat single handed

How to get here

The dinghy park is situated remotely from the main RTYC Clubhouse on the banks of the Tay. To reach the dinghy park you need to park in Douglas Terrace and then push your boat along the promenade. If searching on a Sat-Nav or Navigation software/google maps, etc. then search for **Douglas Terrace, Broughty Ferry, Dundee**. This will give the best location to reach the promenade. From the main road (A930) turn into Douglas Terrace and go over the bridge and about 50 metres after this you will see the promenade on the right.

Once you have dropped your boat off then return to your car and turn round, go back over the bridge and turn left onto the main road. Go along the road to Ogilvie Road on the left, then go down the hill which turns to the right and the RTYC car park and Clubhouse is straight ahead. Go over the railway line to reach the dinghy park.



Where to Stay

There are a number of hotels and other accommodation in the Dundee and Broughty Ferry area.

Campervans and motorhomes can be parked in the car park, there is limited electrical hook-up available. Toilets and changing rooms are available in the beach clubhouse, there is a shower in the main clubhouse. Bacon rolls, tea, coffee, etc. will be available on Saturday and Sunday mornings in the beach clubhouse.
